



DOGS REGULATION



- Dogs are welcome at the campsite, they must be on a lead at all times.
- Dogs are not allowed in the sports area, swimming pool, mobile homes, apartments, on the central beach and on the lakefront grass.
- Dogs must be accompanied outside the campsite for their needs. In case of liquid and/or solid waste inside the campsite, out of respect for people and nature that surrounds you, we kindly ask you to "wash" the liquid waste with water or in case of solid waste to remove it with appropriate bags.

REGULATION FOR ADMISSION OF DOGS ON THE BEACH (RIVER ONLY next to the boat slip)

1. The entrance of dogs on the beach is allowed only on the beach called River (next to the boat slip) from **9.00 to 18.30**.
2. The owner must avoid prolonged barking and excessively lively behavior of his dog or otherwise dangerous and that could disturb the peace of the beach. Otherwise it will be required to leave the beach.
3. It is forbidden the entrance to the beach to dogs with aggressive behavior.
4. It is absolutely forbidden that dogs emit liquid and solid droppings on the beach.
5. Any solid droppings must be immediately removed using appropriate bags and deposited in the dedicated containers. Otherwise it will be reported and the immediate expulsion will be requested.
6. Dogs must always be on a lead.
7. Dogs must never be left unattended and free to roam the beach.
8. Owners are always responsible for any damage to property or persons that may be caused by their dogs.
9. Dogs hosted at the same time on the beach: maximum n° 7
10. In the water the dog is free, but the responsibility of its actions is always of the owner.

It is possible to "wash" dogs using the special fountain on the beach-river, it is absolutely forbidden to use soap.

It is forbidden to wash the dogs using the showers on the beach, inside the hygienic services, in the baby-rooms or at the camper-service
